I also understand that the preliminaries, semi-finals and finals of the Competition will be held in New York in 2020. I am committed to follow the instructions and rules set by the organizers, and I will not withdraw at any time from the competition without the consent of the organizers. I agree to allow the organizers to use my resume, all my photos and video footages during the entire competition to be used for promotional and commercial purposes. I promise to provide correct information about myself and background. I have the responsibility to explain and correct any ambiguity or inaccuracy concerning my personal data during the competition process.

By entering into this Agreement, I am not relying on any oral or written representation or statements made by any person, other than what is set forth in this Agreement. I agree that this Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of New York, U.S.A. I hereby declare that I am the contestant. ## Visa Guide for Traveling to the United States

1) Typically your passport must not expire within six months of your arrival date in the United States. If your passport is going to expire within six months of arrival, you should get a new passport before traveling.

2) The following are general guidelines; for details and authoritative information, please consult: <http://travel.state.gov/content/visas/english.html> If you already have a visa to enter the United States, or other officially-recognized credentials, then you needn't apply for a separate visa specifically for the 'International Chinese Vocal Competition'.

Those from the 27 countries following that are part of the Visa Waiver Program don't need to obtain a visa to enter the United States. [#1] Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Monaco, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom

3) Citizens of Canada and Bermuda are typically not required to get a visa.

4) Other countries and regions require a visa to enter the United States. Typically, you can process a 'Visitors Visa' (B Visa). Those who wish to apply for this visa should first contact us to confirm your participation and receive an invitation letter to use as part of your application. The waiting and processing period differs between countries. Participants should make their visa applications as soon as possible to ensure processing.

Note [#1] Note that if you come from one of the 27 countries in the Visa Waiver Program, then you only need to ensure you're registered in the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA), and you are eligible to stay in the United States for 90 days. All travelers must have machine-readable passports.

## Registration Fee [#2]

1) US\$120 (including one ticket for the "International Chinese Vocal Competition Finals" in New York).

2) Method of payment: major credit cards, cash, traveler's checks, or money orders.

3) Please make the check payable to New Tang Dynasty Television at the address above.

Note [#2]: Under normal circumstances, applicant's registration becomes valid only after he or she has paid the registration fee. For applicants who cannot prepay the registration fee due to special difficulties, they are required to submit a formal written request to delay the payment of registration fee until the time of competition. There will be a US\$20 surcharge in such cases.
